

## How-to Use the Dictionary

1. Go to the “English – Lakǰól’iyapi” section of the Dictionary (back section)

2. Find the word you want to learn

*For Example, say you want to say “I am tired” in Lakota, search for the verb “tired”*

3. Read through the various definitions of the word until you find the one that works best

*Once you have found “tired,” read the possible ways to say tired, the first definition (1) will work:  
“watúkǰa”*

4. Go to the “Lakǰól’iyapi – English” (front section)

5. Find the Lakota word that you looked up in English

*Now that you have found “watúkǰa”, read through the example sentences to make sure it is what you mean to say*

6. Find the ► symbol, followed by 1s: (First Singular conjugation, “I” form) and 1p: (First Plural conjugation, “We” form)

*Here, you will find: ► 1s: wamátukǰa. (I am tired) 1p: waúntukǰapi. (We are tired)*
